

Small and Medium-Sized Businesses Vulnerabilities Report

The SMBVR is the first cybersecurity research report in the world focused exclusively on small and medium-sized businesses (SMBs) to detect any significant vulnerabilities that an attacker could exploit from the outside.

Q2 | 2022

The focus of the research was to detect any significant, visible vulnerabilities in a SMB's website, software or application exposed to the Internet and accessible to an attacker.

The scope of SMBVR Q2 2022 was expanded to cover 16 SMB segments that are current targets of threat actors. New, critical segments that were added include hospitals, utilities, banks and credit unions.

The 19,375 randomly selected SMBs revealed significantly high levels of three vulnerabilities across all SMB segments in both U.S. and Canada:
